# Historic Site Art Contest

## Guidelines

The Wauwatosa Historical Society sponsors this contest to promote appreciation for the unique historic buildings in our community. This project honors the work of early Wauwatosa citizens to create these buildings, and develops an understanding of preservation. All Wauwatosa students in K4 through fifth grade are invited to submit entries.

To enter:

1. Create a representation of the exterior of your favorite historically designated building. Go to the Student Art Contest page at [www.wauwatosahistoricalsociety.org](http://www.wauwatosahistoricalsociety.org) for eligible buildings.
2. View the building by visiting the location (make sure you stay on public property), looking at photographs at WHS or on the WHS website, or finding a photograph of the building.
4. Create your work of art. All two-dimensional media are accepted: pencil, ink, watercolor, acrylic, marker, crayon, etc.
5. Maximum paper size is 18" x 12".
6. Matting is optional, but please attach all artwork to a firm backing.
7. Fill out the contact information and release form below and submit your artwork to your school's art teacher or contest coordinator.

### Important Dates

- WHS picks up completed artwork from the schools **on April 26th and April 27th.**
- Judges select the top two entries per grade; students are notified the week of **May 1.**
- Mayor Kathy Ehley presents awards at the Common Council Meeting on **Tuesday, May 15.**
- Winning artwork is on display during **Historic Preservation Month** at the Little Red Store on **Thursday, May 17, 6-8pm** and **Saturday, May 19, 11am-1pm.**
- All artwork is returned to the student by **June 6.**
