Historic Site Art Contest

Guidelines

The Wauwatosa Historical Society sponsors this contest to promote appreciation for the unique historic buildings in our community. This project honors the work early Wauwatosa citizens did to create these buildings, and develops an understanding of preservation. All Wauwatosa students in K4 through fifth grade are invited to submit entries.

To enter:

1. Create a representation of the exterior of your favorite historically designated building. Go to the Student Art Contest page at www.wauwatosahistoricalsociety.org for eligible buildings.
2. After you've selected a building, view it by visiting the location (make sure you stay on public property), looking at photographs on the WHS website, or finding a photograph of the building elsewhere.
4. Create your work of art. All two-dimensional media are accepted: pencil, ink, watercolor, acrylic, marker, crayon, etc.
5. Maximum paper size is 18" x 12".
6. Matting is optional, but please attach all artwork to a firm backing.
7. Fill out the contact information and release form below and submit your artwork to your school's art teacher or contest coordinator.

Important Dates

- A WHS representative picks up artwork from the schools **on Tues., Apr. 11 or Wed., Apr. 12.**
- Judges select the top two entries per grade; students are notified **the week of Apr. 16.**
- Mayor Kathy Ehley presents awards at the Common Council Meeting on **Tues., May 2.**
- Winning artwork is on display during **Historic Preservation Month in May.** See [the Little Red Store page](#) on our website to confirm dates and exact times. All artwork is returned to the schools by **Fri., June 2.**
